

Idaho Stroke Form

Stroke and STEMI registry data is used to evaluate how the Stroke/STEMI system is functioning at a regional and state level. Stroke/STEMI data collection is required by hospitals if seeking state Stroke or STEMI designation. The TSE registry has a software vendor-Image Trend-that allows for the collection of data items by the hospital and is free of charge. Reports are generated for hospital, regional and state use from the Stroke/STEMI data.

The Image Trend Idaho Stroke Form contains:

Demographic: personal information regarding the patient such as date of birth, address, race and ethnicity

Arrival and Admission Information: a dropdown list of hospitals which may have transferred the patient to your hospital, questions regarding: inter-facility transfer and mode of arrival date of last known well, date of discovery of stroke symptoms, admit/discharge information, ED dwell times, and the discharge disposition and team activation/consulting services.

NIH Stroke Scale at Time of Discharge: produces NIH scale score by entering score manually or addressing each drop down, and questions regarding; Brain imaging, CT results, hospital admission/discharge, TPA, Reperfusion and door to needle time.

Diagnosis: the diagnosis code using ICD-10.

Rankin Scale Score at Time of Admission and Discharge: date, time of Rankin admission and discharge score.

Facility Questions: date, time of prearrival notification from EMS.

SAVE or SAVE AND CONTINUE after entering information to save your entry.
