Event Date	The date on which treatment was first sought for patient's stroke symptoms	MMDDYYYY
Last known well date	The date on which the patient was most recently feeling normal or well	MMDDYYYY
Last known well time	The time at which the patient was most recently feeling normal or well	HHMM (military time)
Mode of arrival	The mode by which the patient arrives at the emergency department	Privately Owned Vehicle, Ground Ambulance, Air Ambulance
Pre-arrival notification	Did the transporting EMS agency notify the emergency department of an incoming stroke patient?	Yes, No, NA, Not know/Not recorded
Date of Arrival at ED /Acute Care	The date the patient arrived at the emergency department	MMDDYY
ED Discharge Disposition	Where Pt Discharged to from ED	Cath lab, Transferred to another hospital, ICU, Home, Expired, Floor bed
Time of arrival at ED/Acute Care	The time at which the patient arrived at the emergency department	HHMM(Military Time)
Admission date	The date on which the patient was admitted as an inpatient to the hospital	MMDDYYYY (Military Time)
Admission time	The time at which the patient was admitted as an inpatient to the hospital	HHMM (military time)
Admission NIHSS score	The patient's score according to the National Institutes of Health Stroke Scale at the time of his or her admission as an inpatient to the hospital - <a href="http://www.idahotrauma.org/Documents/NIH.pdf">http://www.idahotrauma.org/Documents/NIH.pdf</a>	MMDDYYYY (Can add multiple scores)
Date of head CT	The date on which the patient received the first head CT	HHMM (military time)

Date CT results reported to provider	The date on which the patient's CT results were read	HHMM (military time)
Time CT results reported to provider	The time at which the patient's CT results were read	HHMM
If TPA not given, exclusion criteria	The reason for which the patient was not given TPA	Outside the window, Hemorrhagic stroke, Traumatic injury, Uncontrolled hypertension, Seizure at time of stroke, Other (able to Make note)
Date TPA given	The date on which TPA was administered to the patient	HHMM (military time)

Date of endovascular intervention	The date on which endovascular intervention was performed ie: groin stick, catheter deployment, or recanalization.	HHMM (military time)
Time of endovascular intervention	The time at which endovascular intervention was performed ie: groin stick, catheter deployment, or recanalization.	MMDDYYYY
Date of reperfusion	The date on which reperfusion was performed on the patient ie: groin stick, catheter deployment, or recanalization.	HHMM (military time)
Time of reperfusion	The time at which reperfusion was performed on the patient ie: groin stick, catheter deployment, or recanalization.	MMDDYYYY
If transferred, door-in-door-out times	The time elapsed between the patient's arrival in the emergency department to the time the patient left the hospital to be transferred to another facility	HHMM (military time)
If transferred, name of secondary receiving center	The facility to which the patient was transferred after receiving initial hospital care.	MMDDYYYY
Discharge date	The date on which the patient was discharged as an inpatient from the <b>hospital</b> for stroke symptoms.	HHMM (military time)
Discharge time	The time at which the patient was discharged as an inpatient from the hospital for stroke symptoms.	HHMM (total elapsed time)
Discharge Rankin Score	The patient's Rankin score according to the modified Rankin scale at the time of his or her Admission.	0-6

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Discharge NIHSS score	The patient's Rankin score according to the National Institutes of Health Stroke Scale at the time of his or her discharged.	0-6
Hospital Discharge disposition	The patient's destination upon being discharged from the hospital	Home, Transfer to higher level of care, Skilled nursing facility, Rehabilitation Facility, Expired
ICD-10 code	ICD-10 code indicating a STROKE diagnosis	Dx at time of assesment
Date of pre-arrival notification	Date on which the transporting EMS agency notified the emergency department of an incoming stroke patient	DDMMYYYY
Time of pre-arrival notification	Time at which the transporting EMS agency notified the emergency department of an incoming stroke patient	HHMM
