

## IDAHO TRAUMA REGISTRY INCLUSION CRITERIA

Data should be reported to the Idaho Trauma Registry (ITR) for all patients with a discharge ICD-10-CM diagnosis code of:

- **S00-S99** with 7<sup>th</sup> character modifiers of A, B, or C ONLY  
(injury to specific body parts-initial encounter)
- **T07** with unspecified multiple injuries
- **T14** with injury of unspecified body region
- **T20-T28** with 7<sup>th</sup> character modifier of A ONLY  
(burns by specific body parts-initial encounter)
- **T30-T32** with burn by total body surface area (TBSA)
- **T33-34** frostbite
- **T68** hypothermia
- **T71** asphyxiation
- **T75.1** drowning and nonfatal submersion
- **T75.4** electrocution
- **T79.AO-T79.A9** with 7<sup>th</sup> character modifier of A ONLY  
(Traumatic Compartment Syndrome-initial encounter)

**AND** were admitted as an inpatient,  
**OR** died,  
**OR** were transferred out by ambulance or transferred in by ambulance  
and meet the remaining criteria.

### CRITERIA EXCLUDE:

Late effect of injuries, poisoning, and toxic effect.  
Superficial injuries if it is the only injury.  
Contusions with intact skin surface if it is the only injury.  
Foreign body entering through orifice.  
Patients with a single extremity bone fracture/dislocation from a ground level fall.  
Pelvic ring fractures or dislocation are NOT exempt.
